Lekhana was designed for body text in Buddhist Publications. A full range of Latin character sets means it can be used for Pali, Sanskrit, Romanised Indic scripts, many European languages, and Vietnamese. The default line-spacing for 10 point text is 12 points.

A full Greek character set, and a wide range of symbols extend its usefulness to maths and science. Maths and currency symbols are designed on the figure width, while other symbols, arrows, and geometric shapes are a uniform width and align with the Caps height wherever the design permits.

Superscripts align with the tops of figures, and
subscripts bisect the baseline. Ordinals 1st 2ND
3rd 1^È 3^Ù use superscripts only after figures.

The font includes a full set of arrows, symbols, dingbats, and stacking fractions or regular fractions for measurements: $7\frac{3}{8}$ " or $\frac{1}{8}$ etc. Some of the many symbols included are shown below:



Alternate Annotation Forms use Enclosed Alphanumerics, Ornaments use Dingbats, Character Variants use Miscellaneous Symbols Stylistic Alternates, Randomize, and Swashes use the Swash Glyphs. Currently, only a few applications support Colour Font Technology, so most users will see only Black Swashes. The Glyphs in this Paragraph were Colourised Manually using The PagePlus Swatches Tab.
