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Sukhumala was designed for body text in Buddhist Publications. It is derived from Goudy Scot Mills. “*Sukhumāla*” is Pāli for “Tender” or “Graceful.”

A full range of Latin characters means it can be used for Pali, Sanskrit, Romanised Indic scripts, many European languages, and Vietnamese.

A Basic Greek character set, and a wide range of symbols extend its usefulness to other academic fields such as maths and science. Maths and currency symbols are designed on the figure width.

Superscripts align with the tops of figures, and subscripts bisect the baseline. There are ordinals for lower and upper case: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 1^{ème} 2^o, 3^ü, and 16th 25TH. The default line-spacing for 10 point text is 13 points — I recommend using 120% of pointsize unless you’re typing Vietnamese, which needs the extra space above the glyphs for accents like Å.

The font includes a full set of arrows, symbols, dingbats, and stacking fractions for measurements: $1\frac{1}{2}$ " $2\frac{1}{8}$ " $3\frac{3}{10}$ " $4\frac{1}{4}$ etc. A selection of the many symbols is shown below:
